<b>Course description</b>	The module elaborates the scientific material which interrelates the theoretical knowledge and the practical aspect of laws, legal norms, with emphasis on the following topics: Business Law-Meaning; Business Law and Transition Economy; Business Law Entities; Legal Relations; Legal Resources of Business Law; Trade associations in Kosovo; Privatization Process and its Impact on Economy; Business Agencies in Kosovo; Bankruptcy; Liquidation and Reorganization of Legal Persons; Banking Rules and Procedures; Loan Contracts; Competition Law; Prohibited Agreements; Abuse of Dominant Position; Foreign Direct Investments; Concessions; Intellectual Property; Trademarks; Industrial Design; Business Contracts; Out-of-Court Selection of Economic Disputes; Arbitration; Arbitration Procedures; Form and Effect of Decision; Mediation.
<b>Course aims:</b>	Students will be acquainted and will gain knowledge of business law in general with a particular focus on the legal norms that prevail in different countries, with a focus on Kosovo; the role and the way of applying laws to commercial companies; domestic and international appeal procedures; arbitration in resolving business disputes. Students will be introduced to the importance of foreign investment as a determinant in a country's economic development; intellectual property; contracts and their types; through taking examples and discussing group issues.
